Iesus' Church

Christ is Risen; Truly He is Risen! Alleluia! Alleluia! In today's gospel, we hear a portion of what is known as the 'High Priestly Prayer' of Jesus as he prays for his disciples at the Last Supper: "Holy Father... As you sent me into the world, so I sent them into the world." This is John's version of the great commission for the apostles and the Church to extend Christ's work of salvation to the ends of the earth.

Every Sunday in reciting the Creed, we profess faith not only in the Blessed Trinity and their work of our salvation, but also in the Church, which is 'one, holy, catholic, and apostolic.' These for qualities are known as the 'marks' of the Church. In embarking upon the process of 'Next Generation Parish," Corpus Christi is seeking renewal, so that not only individually, but also communally we will live our Baptismal vocation more faithfully, more effectively, and with greater vitality.

The Catholic Leadership Institute, which directs the 'Next Generation Parish" process, highlights 4 characteristics of vitality. A renewed parish 1) Fosters Spiritual Maturity, 2) Offers a Vibrant Sunday Experience, 3) Embraces a Missionary Impulse, and 4) Shares Leadership. To promote each of these 4 dynamics, our parish Envisioning Team has identified 3 pillars or core values present here at Corpus Christi that will assist us in fostering the renewal and growth of our parishioners and our parish. These core values are 1) Reverence, 2) Discipleship, and 3) Communio.

- ◆ *Reverence*, which is God-focused, blossoms from the Holy Spirit's gift of wonder and awe, and guides us to acknowledge the Lord as the One worthy of all our love, devotion, and gratitude. As reverence deepens, we will love the Lord God with our whole being, always seek His will, and love others as Jesus commands.
- Discipleship, which is Mission-focused, guides us to answer the Lord Jesus' call to come and follow him by growing and maturing in our relationship with him. Discipleship will deepen our experience of Jesus' love for us, and in turn transform us into persons who embody this love in every one of our relationships and interactions.
- ◆ *Communio*, which is Heaven-focused, encompasses the invisible union with God and among believers and the visible manifestation of that union, which is membership in the Church, the Mystical Body of Christ. *Communio* will animate us to pursue our longing for God and heaven by strengthening the ways we experience and live out our Catholic lives each day until Jesus comes again.

Una parroquia renovada 1) Fomenta la madurez espiritual, 2) Ofrece una experiencia dominical vibrante, 3) Adopta un impulso misionero y 4) Comparte liderazgo. - ◆ El discipulado, que se centra en la misión, nos guía a responder al llamado del Señor Jesús de venir y seguirlo creciendo y madurando en nuestra relación con él. El discipulado profundizará nuestra experiencia del amor de Jesús por nosotros y, a su vez, nos transformará en personas que encarnan este amor en cada una de nuestras relaciones e interacciones.
- ◆ Communio, que está centrada en el Cielo, abarca la unión invisible con Dios y entre los creyentes y la manifestación visible de esa unión, que es la membresía en la Iglesia, el Cuerpo Místico de Cristo. Communio nos animará a perseguir nuestro anhelo de Dios y del cielo fortaleciendo las formas en que experimentamos y vivimos nuestra vida católica cada día hasta que Jesús regrese. P. Allan F. 
