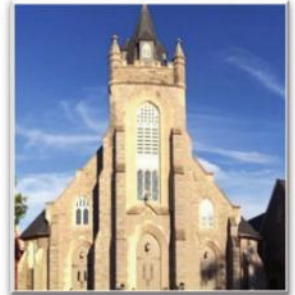

## Love the Lord, Your God . . .

As we arrive at the final weeks of the liturgical year, our Scripture readings challenge us to be whole-hearted disciples of the Lord Jesus:

*Hear, O Israel! The Lord our God is Lord alone!  
You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart,  
with all your soul, with all your mind,  
and with all your strength.  
The second is this: You shall love your neighbor as your-  
self.*

Far from being a collection of spiritual sentiments or doctrinal ideas, our Catholic faith in the Risen Lord must transform our whole being—our attitudes, our priorities, our decisions—and be lived out in daily life. How do we make sure that our faith is not something we wear around our neck, but instead dwells in and animates our hearts?

**Gratitude** or **Thankfulness** to God is essential for a deep and proper relationship with the Lord, for it directs the Christian to recognize, appreciate and respond to our ever-merciful, Loving God. The more we recognize that every blessing in our lives comes from God and that they are God's gifts to us, not what God owes us, the more we are thankful.

Thankfulness is essential, for it orients us aright toward God and motivates us to be responsible in using all of the Lord's gifts for His glory and honor and the good of others. For this reason it is **'right and just'** that we **'give thanks to the Lord our God.'**

We call this response and responsibility **Stewardship**. Stewardship is a spiritual, Biblical principle that acknowledges that all the Good in our lives have been entrusted to us by the Lord God. The faithful disciple loves the Lord God with his whole being by being a good steward of all of the Lord's blessings. **Stewardship** is lived out through:

**Prayer** focuses us on God's will and cultivates our union with God. Am I a person of prayer seeking greater union with God or a person who simply says prayers?

**Time** is the Lord's gift by which we live each moment of our earthly life. Does God get the best of my time?

**Talent** is the opportunity to serve the Lord through others with my specific abilities. Do I serve me or others?

**Treasure** is all the material resources I have. Do I offer God a tenth of these blessings (a tithe) to express my gratitude?

La **Gratitud** o **Agradecimiento** a Dios es esencial para una relación profunda y adecuada con el Señor, ya que dirige al cristiano a reconocer, apreciar y responder a nuestro Dios amoroso y siempre misericordioso. Cuanto más reconocemos que cada bendición en nuestra vida proviene de Dios y que son los dones de Dios para nosotros, no lo que Dios nos debe, más agradecidos estamos.

El agradecimiento es esencial, ya que nos orienta correctamente hacia Dios y nos motiva a ser re-

sponsables al usar todos los dones del Señor para Su gloria y honor y el bien de los demás. Por eso es **"justo y necesario"** que **"demostramos gracias al Señor nuestro Dios"**.

Esta respuesta y esta responsabilidad es la **Cooresponsabilidad**. La Cooresponsabilidad es un principio espiritual y bíblico que reconoce que todo el Bien en nuestras vidas nos ha sido confiado por el Señor Dios. El discípulo fiel ama al Señor Dios con todo su ser al ser un buen administrador de todas las bendiciones del Señor. La Cooresponsabilidad se vive a través de:

**La Oración** nos enfoca en la voluntad de Dios y cultiva nuestra unión con Dios. ¿Soy una persona de oración que busca una mayor unión con Dios o una persona que simplemente dice oraciones?

**El Tiempo** es el regalo del Señor mediante el cual vivimos cada momento de nuestra vida terrenal. ¿Dios saca lo mejor de mi tiempo?

**El Talento** es la oportunidad de servir al Señor a través de otros con mis habilidades específicas. ¿Me sirvo a mí o los demás?

**El Tesoro** son todos los recursos materiales que tengo. ¿Le ofrezco a Dios una décima parte de estas bendiciones (un diezmo) para expresar mi gratitud?

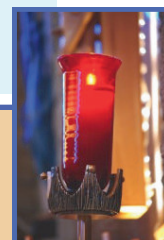
