The Call to Discipleship

In today's gospel, the Lord Jesus inaugurates his public ministry by proclaiming, "***This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel.***" In addition, he begins to call men to be his disciples. Saint Mark emphasizes the urgency of this call by indicating that Peter and Andrew **immediately** follow him. Again when the Lord sees James and John, he **immediately** calls them and they follow. The urgency and importance of the call to be disciples of the Lord and our response cannot be overstated. This is the heart of the Christian life.

This call to discipleship by the Lord is a continuation of last Sunday's invitation by Jesus, 'Come and See,' so that we might abide with Him. We can foster growth as disciples in many ways, but like the disciples in today's gospel, we must decide and then act. Let us do so TODAY!
