## Will You Be My ... Disciple?

This year the confluence of two, well-known days provides an excellent, enthusiastic jump start to our annual season of deepening conversion. With Valentine's Day this Wednesday, our attention focuses on hearts and love. And those, too, are the focus of Ash Wednesday, which is February 14<sup>th</sup> this year. As we hear the

invitation *"Repent and Believe in the Gospel,"* we understand the Lord's call is for deepening conversion of our hearts so as to love more selflessly.

Perhaps for many, Ash Wednesday and Lent evoke depressing, negative sentiments or somber memories; after all, we don ashes on our foreheads with the words, *"Remember you are dust and unto dust you shall return."* Even the



traditional Lenten practices of prayer, self-denial, and almsgiving tend to have a negative ring to them for many people. Yet, as we understand the true spirit of Lent—the re-formation and renewal of our Hearts—we can embrace Lent and these Lenten practices with joy. Lent is not about 'No,' but about 'Yes' to loving fully, and this loving fully brings joy. This re-formation and renewal occurs through intentionally following the Lord Jesus as his Disciples.

I urge you to consider in the next few days the ways in which you will embrace faithful Discipleship through the traditional, Lenten practices of prayer, self-denial, and almsgiving. These traditional practices help us embrace the disciplines of our Christian discipleship.

**Prayer** – as the means of greater communion with the Lord, prayer opens us to living in the Lord's life, love and friendship. Consider:

- Daily Mass, and bring a family member or friend
- Daily family Rosary
- Renewing or deepening your daily habit of prayer
- Setting aside 15 minutes daily to read God's Word & use the 'little black Lenten book'
- Using an Examination of Conscience each night

**Self-Denial** – like weight training for the soul, self-denial strengthens our ability to choose God's will over our own and reject sin, evil and selfishness. Consider:

- Giving up some simple pleasures like dessert, sweets, soda, beer, etc.
- Fasting from wasting time with television, social media, the internet, electronic gaming, etc.
- Developing a more balanced life of prayer, exercise, sleep, and family activities.

**Almsgiving** - contributing to this year's Diocesan Annual Campaign, which serves a wider range of people throughout the diocese & other Works of Mercy.

# ¿Serías mi ... Discípulo?

Este año, la confluencia de dos días bien conocidos proporciona un excelente y entusiasta comienzo de nuestra temporada anual de conversión cada vez más profunda. Al ser este miércoles el día de San Valentín, nuestra atención se centra en los corazones y el amor. Y esos, también, son el tema central del Miércoles de Ceniza, que este año es el 14 de febrero. Cuando escuchamos la invitación **"Arrepiéntanse y crean en el Evangelio",** entendemos que el llamado del Señor es a profundizar la conversión de nuestros corazones para amar sin egoism.

Quizás para muchos, el Miércoles de Ceniza y la Cuaresma evocan sentimientos deprimentes, negativos o recuerdos sombríos; después de todo, nos ponemos cenizas en la frente con las palabras: *"Recuerda que eres polvo y al polvo has de volver*". Incluso las prácticas tradicionales de la Cuaresma de oración, abnegación y limosna tienden a tener un tono negativo para muchas personas. Sin embargo, a medida que entendemos el verdadero espíritu de la Cuaresma, la reformación y renovación de nuestros Corazones, podemos abrazar la Cuaresma y estas prácticas de Cuaresma con alegría. La Cuaresma no se trata de "No", sino de "Sí" para amar plenamente, y este amar plenamente trae alegría. Esta reforma y renovación se produce al seguir intencionalmente al Señor Jesús como sus discípulos.

Les insto a que consideren en los próximos días las formas en que adoptarán el discipulado fiel a través de las prácticas tradicionales de la Cuaresma de oración, abnegación y limosna. Estas prácticas tradicionales nos ayudan a abrazar las disciplinas de nuestro discipulado cristiano.

**Oración:** como medio de una mayor comunión con el Señor, la oración nos abre a vivir la vida, el amor y la amistad del Señor. Considerar:

- Misa diaria y traer a un familiar o amigo
- Rosario familiar diario
- Renovar o profundizar su hábito diario de oración
- Dedicar 15 minutos diarios a leer la Palabra de Dios y usar el librito negro de Cuaresma
- Usar un Examen de Conciencia cada noche

**Abnegación:** como el entrenamiento con pesas para el alma, la abnegación fortalece nuestra capacidad para elegir la voluntad de Dios sobre la nuestra y rechazar el pecado, la maldad y el egoísmo. Considerar:

- Renunciar a placeres simples como postre, dulces, refrescos, cerveza, etc.
- Ayunar por perder el tiempo con la televisión, las redes sociales, Internet, los juegos electrónicos, etc.
- Desarrollar una vida más equilibrada de oración, ejercicio, sueño y actividades familiares.

**Dar limosna:** contribuyendo a la Campaña Anual Diocesana de este año, que sirve a una gama más amplia de personas en toda la diócesis, y otras obras de misericordia.

During Lent, Catholics are asked to devote ourselves to seeking the Lord in **prayer**, in reading Scripture, to service by **giving alms**, and to sacrifice through **fasting. Abstinence from meat is required** of Catholics ages 14 and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent. In addition, **Fasting** is required of All Catholics ages 18-59 on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, limiting themselves to one full meal and two smaller meals each day.


