Unless A Grain of Wheat

As we quickly approach the week we call "Holy," the Scriptures beautifully prepare our hearts and minds to enter more deeply and profoundly into the Paschal Mystery—Christ's suffering, death, resurrection, and ascension—by which we are being saved. Today's reading from Jeremiah describes the Lord's promise:

*The days are coming, says the LORD,
when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel
and the house of Judah.
It will not be like the covenant I made with their fathers. . .
But this is the covenant that I will make . . .
I will place my law within them and write it upon their
hearts; I will be their God, and they shall be my people.*

In this we recognize the New and Eternal Covenant we have in the Blood of Christ. God, through Jeremiah, explains that He will offer us this new covenant, by writing on our hearts his law and divine will, so that we may be empowered to relate to Him and one another not through mere external dictate, but by cooperation with God's own will.

We call this awareness of God's law and divine will our **CONSCIENCE**. We promote the development of our conscience through greater understanding of God's Word, through study of our Catholic faith, and through a deeper life of prayer and the sacraments.

A well-formed conscience fosters a deepening relationship with the Lord, whereas a conscience that is poorly or inadequately formed makes us more vulnerable to the ways of the world. With a well-formed conscience, we will be ready to die to sin and selfishness and live more for the Lord, as Jesus indicates:

*Amen, amen, I say to you,
unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies,
it remains just a grain of wheat;
but if it dies, it produces much fruit.*

The Lord is describing not only his own death that gives Life, but also the process of putting selfishness to death so that we might love fully.

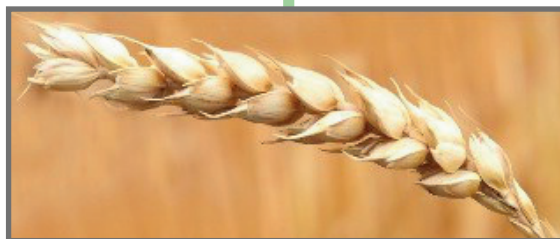
Lent invites us to develop more fully our sensitivity to the LORD who speaks in the depths of our being, that is, through our **CONSCIENCE**. Our conscience then leads us to reconciliation with the LORD through the Sacrament of Confession. Please join us for our **Penance Service** this afternoon or one of the other opportunities for Confession before Easter.

Si el Grano de Trigo no Muere

A medida que nos acercamos rápidamente a la semana que llamamos "Santa", las Escrituras preparan maravillosamente nuestros corazones y mentes para entrar más profundamente en el Misterio Pascual, el sufrimiento, la muerte y la resurrección de Cristo, por el cual somos salvos. La lectura de hoy de Jeremías describe la promesa del Señor:

"Se acerca el tiempo, dice el Señor, en que haré con la casa de Israel y la casa de Judá una alianza nueva. No será como la alianza que hice con los padres de ustedes . . . Ésta será la alianza nueva que voy a hacer. . . Voy a poner mi ley en lo más profundo de su mente y voy a grabarla en sus corazones. Yo seré su Dios y ellos serán mi pueblo.



En esto reconocemos la Alianza Nueva y Eterna que tenemos en la Sangre de Cristo. Dios, a través de Jeremías, explica que Él nos ofrecerá esta alianza nueva, escribiendo en nuestro corazón su ley y voluntad divina, para que podamos tener el poder de

relacionarnos con Él y entre nosotros, no a través de un mero mandato externo, sino mediante la cooperación con la propia voluntad de Dios.

A este conocimiento de la ley de Dios y de la voluntad divina la llamamos la **CONCIENCIA**. Promovemos el desarrollo de nuestra conciencia a través de una mayor comprensión de la Palabra de Dios, a través del estudio de nuestra fe católica y a través de una vida más profunda de oración y sacramentos.

Una conciencia bien formada fomenta una relación más profunda con el Señor, mientras que una conciencia mal formada o inadecuada nos hace más vulnerables a los caminos del mundo. Con una conciencia bien formada, estaremos dispuestos a morir al pecado y al egoísmo y vivir más para el Señor, como indica Jesús:

*Yo les aseguro que
si el grano de trigo, sembrado en la tierra, no muere,
queda infecundo;
pero si muere, producirá mucho fruto.*

El Señor está describiendo no solo su propia muerte que da Vida, sino también el proceso de dar muerte al egoísmo para que podamos amar plenamente.

La Cuaresma nos invita a desarrollar más plenamente nuestra sensibilidad hacia el SEÑOR que habla en lo más profundo de nuestro ser, es decir, a través de nuestra **CONCIENCIA**. Nuestra conciencia entonces nos lleva a la reconciliación con el Señor a través del Sacramento de la Confesión. Únase a nosotros para nuestro Rito de Penitencia esta tarde o una de las otras oportunidades de Confesión antes de Pascua.
