The Week we Call 'HOLY'

This week we call "Holy" is no ordinary week. Yes, it consists of 7 days, 168 hours, 10,080 minutes, or 604,800 seconds like any other week. What makes this week extraordinary is not its length, but the depths to which the

Church invites us to **enter more fully** into the Paschal Mystery. In the Paschal Mystery, the LORD reveals that *"God so loved the world that he gave his only Son."* The whole of Lent has directed us toward the liturgies, prayer, and devotion of Holy Week, so that we might **ENCOUNTER** our Crucified and Risen Lord more personally and be renewed more fully in the new and eternal covenant, by which we are God's beloved sons and daughters.

As Christ entered Jerusalem, so too do we enter into, not a city, but the depths of God's salvific love called the **Paschal Mystery**. This **Paschal Mystery** refers to the suffering, death, resurrection and ascension of Jesus Christ. It is a *mystery*, not because the ending is hidden,

but because it expresses the infinite LOVE of God, which is <u>TOO MUCH</u> for us to understand completely. By his death on the cross, Christ became our Passover sacrifice, the Lamb of God, who offers us reconciliation and the freedom of God's adopted children.

This week we call **HOLY** is the week to postpone our normal activities in order to focus entirely on ENCOUN-TERING Jesus Christ more fully as our Savior, through the liturgies of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday, and Easter Sunday. *Fr. La semana que llamamos 'SANTA'



En el Misterio Pascual, el Señor revela que *"tanto amó Dios al mundo que dio a su único Hijo".* Toda la Cuaresma nos ha orientado hacia las liturgias, la oración y la devoción de la Semana Santa, para que podamos **ENCONTRAR** más personalmente a nuestro Señor Crucificado y Resucitado y renovarnos más plenamente en la nueva y eterna alianza, por la que somos hijos amados de Dios. e hijas.

Así como Cristo entró en Jerusalén, nosotros también entramos, no en una ciudad, sino en las profundidades del amor salvador de Dios llamado el *Misterio Pascual*. Este *Misterio Pascual* se refiere al sufrimiento, muerte, resurrección y ascensión de Jesucristo. Es un misterio, no porque el

final esté oculto, sino porque expresa el AMOR infinito de Dios, que es <u>DEMASIADO</u> para que lo entendamos completamente. Por su muerte en la cruz, Cristo se convirtió en nuestro sacrificio de Pascua, el Cordero de Dios, que nos ofrece la reconciliación y la libertad de los hijos adoptivos de Dios.

Esta semana que llamamos **SANTA** es la semana para posponer nuestras actividades normales para enfocarnos completamente en ENCONTRAR más plenamente a Jesucristo como nuestro Salvador, a través de las liturgias del Jueves Santo, Viernes Santo, Sábado Santo y Domingo de Pascua.




