Christ is Risen!

Christ is Risen; Truly He is Risen! This is the news, the Good News, the women received upon arriving at the tomb.

"Do not be amazed! You seek Jesus of Nazareth, the crucified. He has been raised; he is not here. Behold the place where they laid him."

The women had been impelled to go to the tomb for love of their Lord. They loved the Lord so much that they had not thought ahead, "Who will roll back the stone for us from the entrance of the tomb?" Love impelled them; love would not be denied. Yet, Easter demonstrates that it is **God's Love** that is ALL-POWERFUL, raising Christ from the dead.

Easter proclaims New Life in abundance. Not only do we rejoice that the Lord is Risen, but that he shares New Life concretely with those who become sons and daughters of God through the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. These Easter Sacraments communicate to us the power of the Paschal Mystery.

The Resurrection of the Lord instills such great joy, for it is an event from the <u>past</u> that transfigures the <u>present</u>, so that our <u>future</u> is filled with the abundance of Life. This power of God in His crucified and risen Son <u>only</u> impacts us, if we accept and respond to that amazing Love. Let us reaffirm our commitment to Him and His Church. Let us rejoice in this New Life our Savior has offered us in Baptism and live it fully in the New and Eternal Covenant we have in his Precious Blood.




