Shepherding

In the Sacrament of Holy Baptism, after the pouring of water, infants are anointed on the crown of their head with Sacred Chrism as a reminder to "remain as a member of Christ, Priest, Prophet and King." Holy Baptism incorporates us into the Mystical Body of Christ, the Church, and thus each baptized person shares in Christ's priestly, prophetic, and kingly mission. His kingly mission is that of Good Shepherd.

Today, the Fourth Sunday of Easter, we reflect on the Lord Jesus as our Good Shepherd, who guides, protects, and saves us. The gospel today gives us insight into the heart and character of our Good Shepherd – "I will lay down my life for the sheep." This form of shepherding

not only reveals the love the Good Shepherd has for us, but also inspires his Church to Servant Leadership for the salvation of the world. Because Jesus did not come to be served but to serve, those who shepherd in his footsteps do so, not through power and domination, but in service. In light of our own Baptism, then, all the members of the Church share in Christ's shepherding work to the extent they support and contribute to servant leadership in parishes.

One form of this servant leadership at the parish level is the Parish Pastoral Council. This year Pastoral Council is growing in its own understanding of how it best serves Corpus Christi in its role of shepherding and supporting

the efforts, works, and ministries of parishioners and the parish. In this way, Pastoral Council assists the pastor in his responsibility of shepherding the parish.

Corpus Christi is also tremendously blessed to have been selected to be one of six parishes to participate in the Catholic Leadership Institute's "Next Generation Parish" process. You, the people of Corpus Christi, have already been involved with this process through the Disciple Maker Index, which so many completed in December. Currently, the Envisioning Team is working with our consultant, Dr. Ximena DeBroeck, to formulate our vision and priorities, so that Corpus Christi can fulfill its priestly, prophetic, and shepherding mission in an effective and fruitful fashion.

I am so grateful to the members of the Envisioning Team – Abel Castro, Carlos Espinosa, Renee Galvan, Carlos Jimenez, Rob Mills, Mary Margaret Osterman, Cindy Richards, and Becky Weir, together with Fr. Smith and Deacon Ramsey –who are dedicating such time and attention to this stage of the "Next Generation Parish" process. Without clear vision, well-ordered priorities, and effective organization, parishes fall short of helping more and more to "Know Jesus, Love Jesus, and Follow Jesus." May Jesus, our Good Shepherd, inspire our Shepherding.

Pastoreando

En el Sacramento del Santo Bautismo, después del derramamiento del agua bendita, los niños son ungidos en la coronilla con el Santo Crisma como recordatorio para ser "para siempre miembro de Cristo, Sacerdote, Profeta y Rey". Weekly Assistance Report: For the week ending April 13, your donations provided food to 223 households and helped one household with rent assistance. No groceries were purchased this week.




