The practice of tithing comes from the Old Testament, whereby one tenth of the produce of the land was set aside for the Lord. Tithing not only acknowledges the LORD as the source of all our blessings, but also expresses our trust in Him. In giving the LORD 10 % of our blessings, we express trust that the LORD will ensure that the remaining 90 % will be sufficient for us. Tithing is our prayerful opening of our hearts and our hands to trust more in the LORD. Leviticus 27,30
